What's Involved

Being a Board member at Press Start is a meaningful opportunity to:

- Collaborate in real decisions in a youth-led organization
- Develop leadership, governance, and community-building skills
- Contribute 2–5 hours a month (more for some roles)
- Attend one 2 or 3-hour in-person meeting each month

We're seeking motivated individuals — especially youth aged **25–35** — who can commit to 2–10 hours a month depending on the role. You don't have to be an expert — just committed, collaborative, and ready to learn.

Open Board Positions

1. Secretary

 Organized? Detail-oriented? You're the glue that keeps us running.

- Take meeting notes and send follow-ups
- Confirm meetings and help schedule
- Write and submit board resolutions

- Update the **Registre des entreprises**

2. Treasurer (7–10 hrs/month)



Love numbers and planning? Join us to strengthen our financial vision.

- Review monthly budgets
- Co-develop financial tools
- Support participatory budgeting with youth
- Draft both realistic and dream-budget versions

3. HR Lead



A thoughtful people person? Help shape our internal culture.

- Draft job descriptions
- Join hiring and evaluation processes
- Receive and help resolve complaints

4. Networking Lead



A natural connector? Help us break our community bubble.

- Represent Press Start to new communities (funders, politicians, etc.)
- Support event promotion, ticket sales, and public speaking
- Mentor youth in public presence and networking
- Be proactive in growing our reach — we've hit a ceiling, and we need you to help break through
