WHAT IS THE CLOUD?

- the cloud is the internet!! a network of servers that process and store your data and content
- cloud services make distribution and access possible - any time, any where, on any digital device



When you check your email online you are in the "cloud".

Other cloud-based tools are Dropbox and Evernote.



DROPBOX AS AN EXEMPLARY PRACTICE

What is Dropbox?

- a desktop and web application that enables users to store all types of files ... in the cloud access files from different computers and mobile devices – anywhere you have an internet connection and a web browser
- share access to files and folders with other Dropbox users



Dropbox can be installed on a computer to work like a regular folder and it can be accessed via a web-based interface or on mobile devices such as tablets or smart phones (Android, iOS, Windows). The content synchs automatically.



DROPBOX AS AN EXEMPLARY PRACTICE

- Setup of a program-specific user account
- Desktop version of Dropbox on each student computer automatically synched to the account
- Files in Dropbox folder are automatically accessible on each student computer
- Sub-folders can be shared with instructor account, e.g. folders for activities or for each student
- Dropbox functions as an internal network
- Automatic file backup and remote accessibility
- If learners want to have remote access to their student folder, a student's folder can be shared with the student's account and accessed remotely



What is Evernote?

- a web application that enables users to capture, store and save web pages, notes, photos ... in the cloud
- retrieve all your "stuff" from your computer, smartphone, tablet – anywhere you have an internet connection and a web browser



In addition to the web application, Evernote can be installed on your desktop (Windows and Mac) and mobile devices such as tablets or smart phones (Android, iOS, Windows)



The multi-level class

- learners want to improve their literacy or numeracy skills to transition to work, college or to become more independent
- for most, English is their second language, their level of education is below grade 10 and they aren't comfortable using computers





One instructor/administrator

- on a typical day, a group of learners would work on different activities based on their level and their goal path
- the instructor would go around to observe them at work and to respond to their questions
- some learners would finish faster and get bored or frustrated when they had to wait for further instructions/activities from the instructor who was busy helping someone else





The instructor needed a tool that would:

- allow for more time with emergent learners
- help independent learners function with minimal assistance
- make it easy to organize and manage all kinds of resources for learners (websites, videos, PDFs, Word files and images)
- Allow learners to access websites without having to type in URL each time
- be accessible to learners while they are away from class
- allow lessons to be quickly customized to learner's needs
- not require learners to login with a user name and password
- be easy to use



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

Benefits to the instructor

- save and organize various resources in one place
- can add screen captures instead written instructions
- easier to manage the multi-level class
- learners are more engaged
- learners work at their own pace, open to challenges
- can customize lessons

record of assigned work



Impact on learners

- self-esteem and independence increased
- more confident and open to using technology
- learning other tech skills (tabs, search, print)
- learners try activities and manage their learning
- have access to activities outside of class
- more motivated, more work done = faster progress
- learners challenge themselves and are more persevering
- more collaboration and peer-to-peer help



How can it work for other programs/instructors

For example, instructors can use it to:

- manage your own links and resources
- have organizational Evernote account to share resources
- keep track of assigned learning activities on a daily or weekly basis
- Have learners submit assignments by adding them to their Evernote notebook



Distance Learning Delivery Support (e-Channel)

- e-Channel is a web-based way to deliver LBS training that improves access for Ontarians who choose or are in need of independent distance learning
- The e-Channel network consists of these programs:
 - Avon-Maitland District School Board (Anglophone 'The Learning Hub'
 - Sioux Hudson Literacy Council (Aboriginal) 'Good Learning Anywhere'
 - Coalition Ontarienne de Formation des Adultes (Francophone)
 - George Brown College (Deaf) 'Deaf Learn Now'
 - College Sector Committee for Adult Upgrading 'Academic & Career Entrance Program / ACE Distance'
- AlphaPlus is a support organisation working with all five programs
 - Managed the three-year pilot project to identify delivery models
 - Trained many instructors in Moodle now working in e-Channel
 - Supports onsite programs with tech-enabled solutions to prepare
 - learners for participation in e-Channel programs
